

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees of Jacksonville ISD was held Monday, November 11, 2010, beginning at 6:30 PM in the Board Room of the JISD Administration Bldg., at 1547 Pine Street, Jacksonville, Texas.

All board members were present except Todd Travis. Superintendent, Dr. Joe Wardell was also present at the meeting.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Board President, James Houser, announced that a quorum was present, that the meeting was duly called, and that notice of the meeting had been posted for the time and in the manner as required by law.

 - November 16th: travel to Washington D.C. for following two JISD schools to receive national Blue Ribbon Awards (only 25 schools in Texas named for 2010)
