

The Board of Education of the Jacksonville Independent School District, State of Texas, met on November 12, 2012 at 6:30 p.m. for a Regular Meeting in the Board Room of the JISD Administration Building located at 1547 Pine Street, Jacksonville, Texas.

1. Call to Order

Board President, James Houser, announced that a quorum was present, that the meeting was duly called, and that notice of the meeting had been posted for the time and in the manner as required by law.

- 2. Pledges of Allegiance to United State and Texas Flags James Houser led the pledges of allegiance to both flags.
- Bond Construction Update Jeff Edwards of Claycomb & Associates updated the Board on the bond construction progress:
 - Jacksonville High School (74.3% complete):
 - Science Addition roofing dried-in
 - Science Addition masonry complete
 - Science Addition entrance canopies installed
 - Science Addition interior drywall proceeding
 - MEP rough-in for Science addition proceeding
 - Band Hall demolition complete
 - Band Hall new stud wall construction proceeding
 - Band Hall aluminum doors installed
 - Band Hall mechanical units being installed
 - Connector hall foundation proceeding
 - Next: Science Addition tape/bed/texture/paint; Science Addition ceramic tile; Science Addition casework delivery; completion foundation for connector hall; structural steel for connector hall; Band Hall drywall and finishes; MEP rough-in for Band Hall
 - East Side Elementary, Joe Wright Elementary, and Fred Douglass Elementary campuses are all proceeding with punch list items.
- Consider and Approve 2011-2012 JISD Financial Audit Financial Auditor, Rachel Payne of Robinson & Payne, presented the 2011-2012 JISD Financial Audit and discussed various areas of the audit. She reported an unqualified clean audit with no findings.

 - A. LEA Public Report of Progress in Meeting Highly Qualified Teacher Requirements for 2012-2013
 Human Resources Director, Nancy Lee, reported to members that JISD is currently meeting 99.28% of the Highly Qualified Teacher Requirements (part of No Child Left Behind) for the 2012-2013 school year. She added that the District is currently following a plan to attain 100% by January.
 - B. Update on T.E.A. Snapshot Visit Scheduled for January 2013
 - Judy Terry informed board members that a Snapshot Visit from the Texas Education Agency is scheduled for January 28-29, 2013. The District Snapshot provides districts with a profile of their current capacity to support student success on all campuses. The snapshot allows leaders to move the discussion of school improvement from the individual campus to the district level.

The District Snapshot examines all levels of district operations for a comprehensive analysis and understanding of the current district status in its role of supporting student achievement, by including:

- o surveys of campus and district leaders
- o interviews with stakeholders
- o observations of practice in action
- o analysis of performance and demographic data
- o analysis of district policy, procedures, and protocols."

9. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Dr. Wardell reported:

- Enrollment to-date: <u>4849</u> students; enrollment <u>49</u> students more than end of last school year
- Refinancing of 1998 and 2005 Bonds:
 - o Locked in rates on October 16th closing will be November 20th
 - Initial Target Savings = \$240,697
 - Actual Net Savings = \$327,607 (appx. \$62,000/year for next five years)
- <u>Texas Department of Agriculture</u>: JISD has been certified by the TDA to receive an additional 6-Cents reimbursement for lunches served under the National School Lunch Program. This approval was based on documentation submitted by the District to show compliance with the new meal patterns implemented by the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010. JISD will be subject to random Validation Reviews to validate the submitted information for Certification.
- <u>Security Cameras</u>: will be installing new and improved security cameras at JHS, JMS, Compass, Nichols, Fred Douglass, and West Side campuses
