A. SHAC (School Health Advisory Committee) Report

JISD Head Nurse, Stephanie Wofford, gave a report to the Board on the current health curriculum that has been established for the students by SHAC. She updated the Board on the District's programs in the areas of health and physical education; nutrition and health services; healthy and safe school environment; staff wellness promotion; and parent and community involvement. Ms. Wofford advised board members that the free health curriculum program currently used by the District has been discontinued. The District will need to purchase a new health program for installation into the curriculum for 2013-2014.

B. Region 7 Board of Directors Election

Dr. Wardell advised board members that Places 3 and 5 on the Board of Directors of the Region 7 Education Service Center which are up for election in 2013 each had one unopposed candidate. No ballot will be sent and the election will be cancelled. The following candidates will be certified as having been elected: Dr. Jane Ann Morrison – Place 3, Mr. James G. Partin – Place 5.

C. Discussion on Board Training Available for 2013

Mr. Houser reminded the Board that, prior to the board meeting, each board member had received information on available mandatory training for board members in 2013.
